2017 m. spalio 17-19 d. Varšuvoje (Lenkija) dalyvavau Valdymo komiteto posėdžiuose, Veiklos darbo grupės (WG3) susitikimuose bei baigiamojoje Veiklos IS1302 konferencijoje (detalus susitikimų planas ir konferencijos programa pateikiama 1 priede).

Valdymo komiteto posėdyje buvo aptariama projekto veiklų pažanga ir problemos. Darbo grupės pristatė savo darbo rezultatus. Sutarta dėl galutinės ataskaitos rengimo detalių ir terminų.

Baigiamosios konferencijos metu buvo pristatomi įvairių šalių mokslininkų, praktikų ir politikų pranešimai apie teismo psichiatrijos naujausius tyrimus, teismo psichiatrijos pacientų padėtį Europos šalyse. Susitikimo dalyviams buvo sudaryta galimybė susipažinti su dviem teismo psichiatrijos įstaigomis (Psichiatrijos ir neurologijos institutu Varšuvoje bei didžiausio saugumo teismo psichiatrijos įstaiga Gostynine), pabendrauti su pacientais bei personalu, susipažinti su darbo įstaigose pagrindiniais principais. Veiklos dalyviai nutarė ieškoti naujų finansavimo galimybių bendroms tyrimų idėjoms įgyvendinti.
